

BLOG/REVIEW: Whining about Wine?

I'm not exactly a wine drinker myself. Fermented grapes are just not my cuppa tea; tea is actually more my style. Being a wine novice it can be quite difficult to search for a good organic wine. In my quest for organic wine I stumbled across a great site. WineZap is a free online service that helps wine consumers to find, price, and compare wines.

WineZap assists both fine wine lovers and casual wine drinkers to buy wines by making it easy to find a wine, compare it with other wines, and find the lowest prices.

The wine rating is an excellent tool when purchasing wine, especially if your pallet is not perfected. Ratings by consumers and the ability to search for wines by pairing it with food will help in selecting that special wine for a gift or dinner party.

Typing in the word "organic" revealed a total of 681 wines. Using the column on the right to narrow my results to "food match" I scrolled down through and clicked on "vegetarian" to discover 28 varieties of organic wine to bring along to a vegetarian dinner. Several wines were priced at under \$10 a bottle. The first selection being a wine produced by Badger Mountain, "the Johannisberg Riesling Organic is an excellent Riesling. From the Columbia Valley Washington area of USA, this Riesling features a Dry taste and White color."

Not only does WineZap offer a great search tool, they also have a free newsletter, a special toolbar so your wine selections can be right at your fingertips, an optimized mobile browser version of their website for use on your mobile service and a wine club for those who want to regularly receive top-rated wines shipped to your door.

I decided to revisit my search for organic wine to find a wine that would match up with the Easter present I mentioned in the previous blog. The Blue Iris Bouquet paired with the Lavender Fleur du Sel handmade chocolate caramels from Organic Bouquet would be the perfect gift bundled with a wine that pairs well with chocolate.

Sure enough, chocolate was a food match choice on WineZap giving me the option of 48 wines ranging from \$8 to \$18. I decided to choose A wine produced by Bajac, Domaine de, the Merlot Vin de Pays d'Oc / Organic which is rated as an excellent Merlot. From the Vin de Pays d'Oc Languedoc Roussillon area of France. It states that this Merlot features a Dry taste and Red color.

So if you are searching for that perfect wine, whether you are a connoisseur or a novice WineZap is a great tool to help you decide your choice of wine.
